## Explanatory notes

These composite fees include the costs of the national agreement:

- on payments for the release of teachers
- for practical and oral tests which are part of the normal assessment and for which no extra fees are charged.

The availability of exams in this schedule has been announced in our specifications and other publications.

### Entry Fee

This fee is charged in full for each entry.

### Late Entry Fee

Charged for each entry of a **new** candidate received after the closing date for entries for each exam series. This fee is in addition to the Entry Fee.

### Very Late Entry Fee

Charged for each very late entry of a **new** candidate received after the specified date for each exam series. This fee is in addition to the Entry Fee.

### Amendment Fee

Charged for each amendment to the entries of an **existing** candidate made after the specified date for each exam series. This fee is in addition to the Entry Fee for any new entry.

### Withdrawn candidates

Entry Fees will be refunded for each candidate withdrawn by centres before the specified date for each exam series. Late, Very Late and Amendment fees are not refunded. No refunds are made for candidates withdrawn after these dates (except on medical grounds where partial refunds will be considered) or where candidates are simply absent from the exam. Any request for a partial refund of fees must be accompanied by satisfactory supporting medical evidence. Fees paid cannot be carried forward from one exam/series to another.

## Submission of entries via paper-based entry forms and computer disks

We now receive more than 90% of entries via Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) services. Centres using EDI also receive candidate results electronically. These may be downloaded into the centres' management information systems. Although it is not cost effective to maintain the paper-based/computer disk entry system, we realise that some centres either don't want to use EDI or simply cannot do so. To maintain the system we have, therefore, introduced a surcharge on entries from centres indicating (on their annual Intention to Enter form) that they will not be making any EDI entries in the coming year. Please note: paper Entry Forms for a series are not despatched.

The **non-EDI entry surcharge of £1.50 per entry** will apply to main entries for all qualifications, except those for which an exception is specifically noted in the qualification-specific sections on pages 6 to 18 inclusive.

Entries can also be made online via e-AQA. The non-EDI entry surcharge does not apply to entries made online.
