We want to remind you of the arrangements in place for the withdrawal of the AQA GCE specifications.

The specifications listed below were withdrawn after the June 2009 examinations.

A last opportunity for assessment of A2 units and for candidates to receive overall subject awards at AS and Advanced levels will be available in January 2010.

### Initial Entry Information form

In addition to completing this Estimated Entries form, you will be required to submit an *Initial Entry Information* form if you intend to enter candidates for any of the specifications listed below. The *Initial Entry Information* form **will be sent with the results of the June 2009 GCE examinations for return to AQA by 15 September 2009.**

You will be asked to indicate on the Initial Entry Information form the number of candidates requiring A2 question papers for this final re-sit opportunity.

#### Important note:

Externally assessed units will be available in the January 2010 examination series only where there is demand expressed on the *Initial Entry Information* forms. We regret that we will be unable to accommodate any requests made after 15 September 2009 for units where the examination has not already been requested by a centre.
