

→ Visiting AQA's Manchester office

The office is at Devas Street on the University of Manchester Campus.

By Road

There is almost no public car parking available in the vicinity of the office. You are strongly urged to use the extensive and frequent public transport network to reach the office.

If it is absolutely unavoidable to travel by car, you are advised to use a car park in central Manchester and complete your journey using buses or taxis.

By Rail/Bus

If you are arriving at **Piccadilly Station**, take the exit for the Metro and Taxis, the Fairfield Street exit. On leaving the station, cross Fairfield Street, the road facing you, and walk some 200 metres to your left to the bus stop for the **147 bus**. This leaves every 10 minutes from 7.15 a.m. Book to the **University** on Oxford Road and alight at the **Holy Name Church** (a 10/15 minute journey).

Alternatively, leaving the Station by the exit for Piccadilly Station Approach, walk straight on to the **Piccadilly Gardens Bus Station** (about five minutes) for buses 41, 42, 43, 44, 48, 142, 143 and 157. Book to the **University** on Oxford Road and alight at the **Holy Name Church** (some buses stop directly outside, some 50 metres beyond at the Medical School).

If you are arriving at **Oxford Road Station**, leave the concourse, cross Oxford Road and at the bus stop outside the Palace Hotel (a distinctive late Victorian building in red brick facing you as you leave the station concourse) take any of buses 15, 16, 41, 42, 43, 44, 48, 111, 142, 143 and 157. Book to the **University** on Oxford Road and alight at the **Holy Name Church** (some buses stop directly outside, some 50 metres beyond at the Medical School).

If you are arriving at **Victoria Station** walk up to **Piccadilly Gardens Bus Station** and take one of the buses listed.

Journey times from Piccadilly Station and Oxford Road Station to AQA's offices will be about 15 to 20 minutes, depending on traffic.

The **Holy Name Church** is a distinctive Victoria Gothic building with a prominent tower. At the pedestrian crossing near the church, you are facing the University Union on the left and the Refectory building on the right. Crossing the road, use the pedestrian walkway (Lime Grove) with the Refectory building on the right. The Humanities Building is on the left. Bear left after passing the Humanities Building. AQA's offices are a short walk on the right. It is about a three minute walk from the bus stop to AQA's offices.

By Air

Manchester Airport has rail links to Piccadilly and Oxford Road Stations. From the stations, the office can then be reached by bus, following the directions above, or by taxi. If travelling direct to the office by taxi from the Airport, allow at least 30 minutes. Taxi ranks are situated next to Arrivals at Terminals 1, 2 and 3.

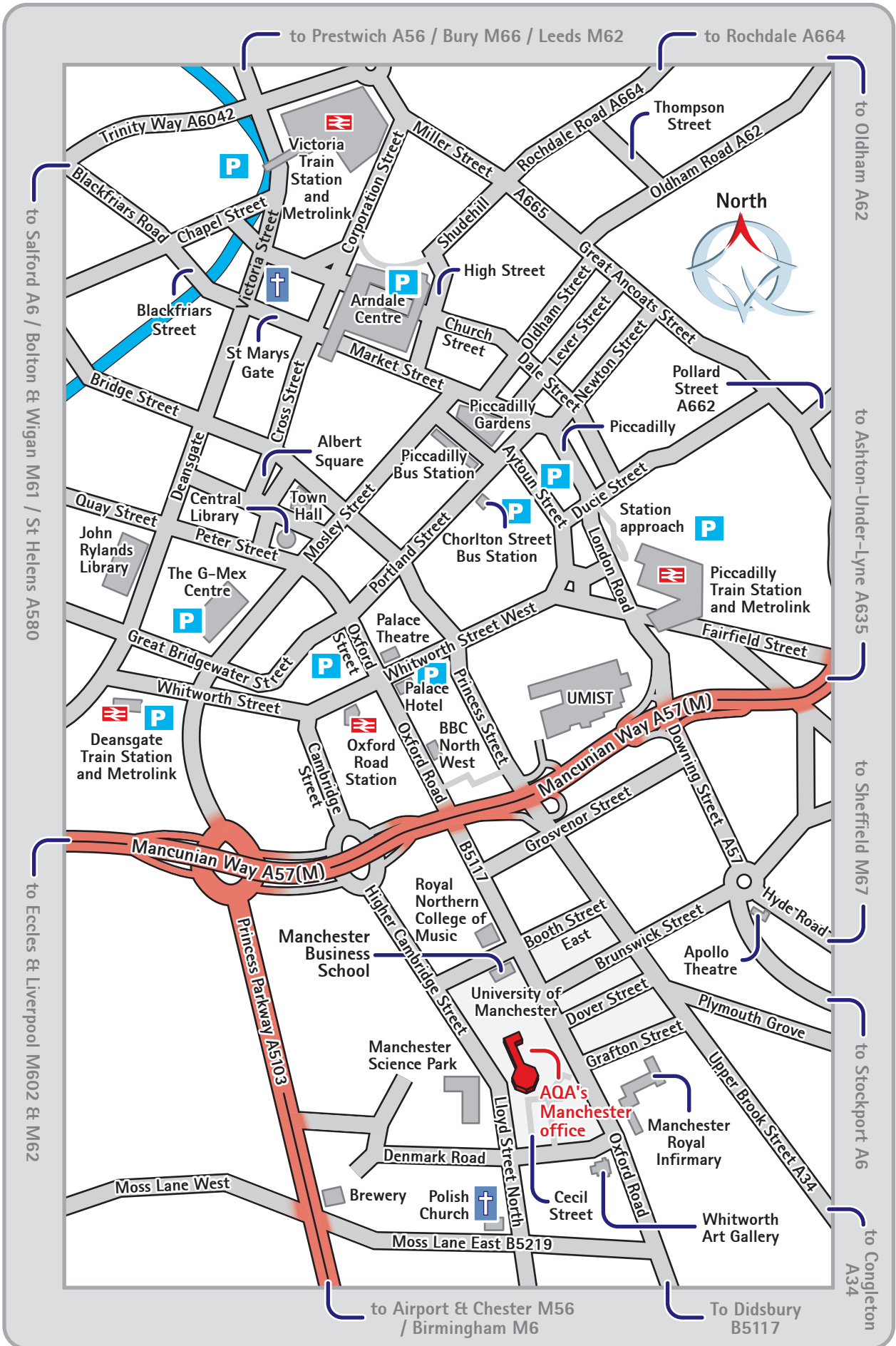

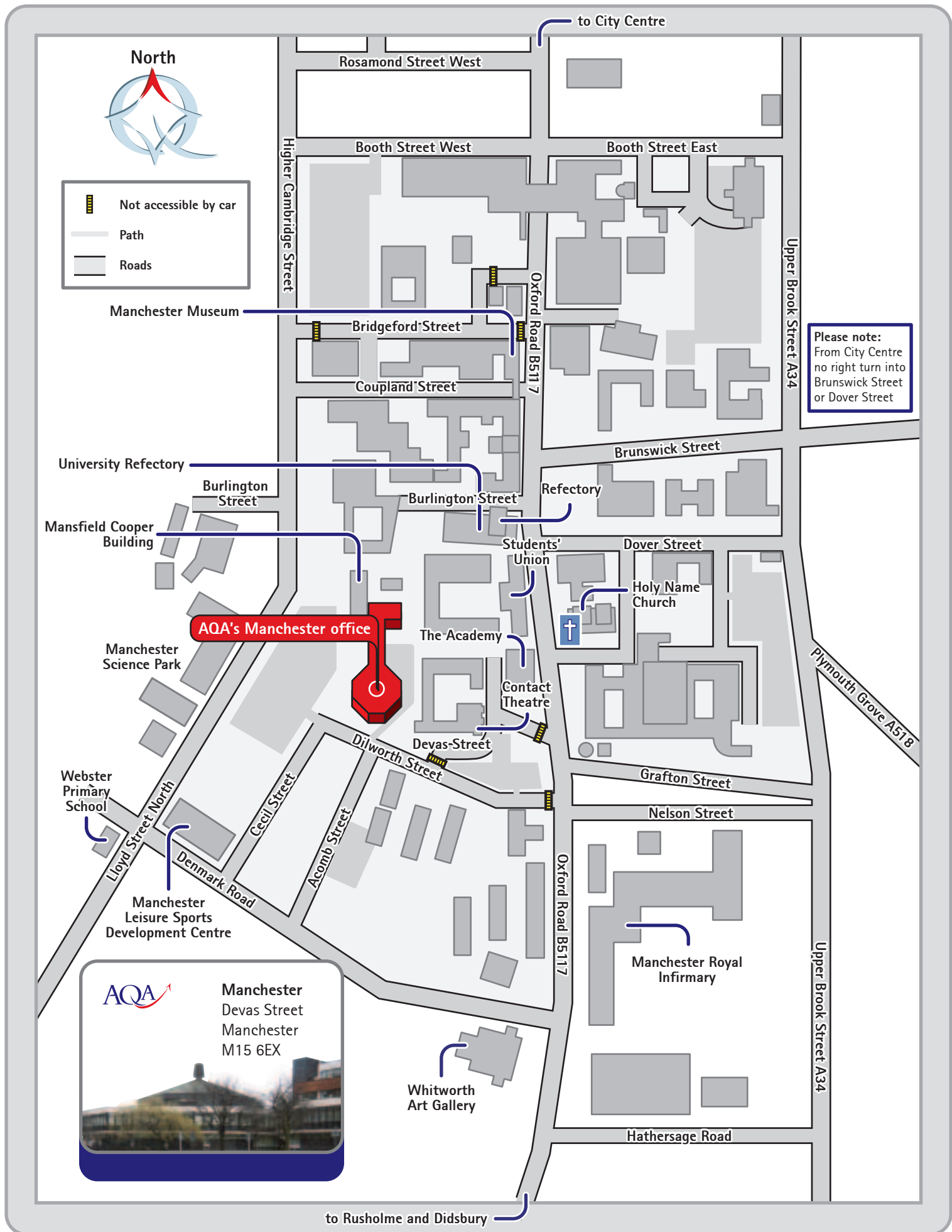
Manchester Map
