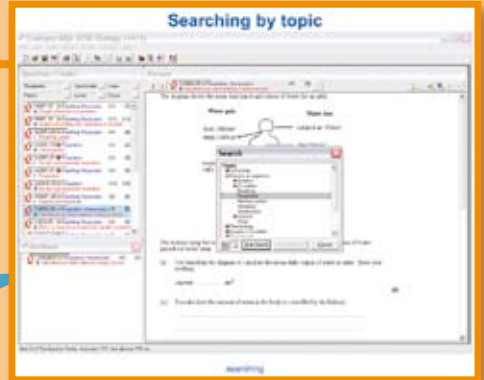


It's easy to use Exampro. Here's how it works.

Imagine you want to create some homework or a test for your class.

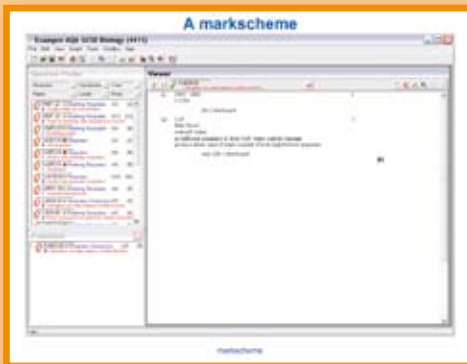
Just search for questions, view them and then 'drag-and-drop' them into an 'Untitled' document. All questions are indexed by various criteria, including by topic.

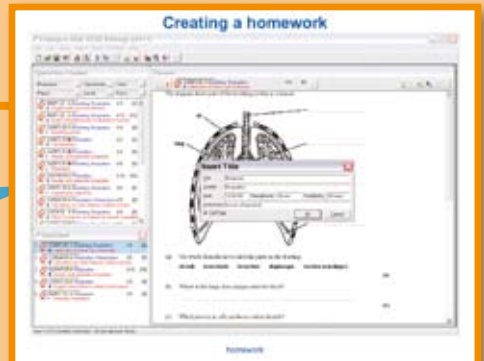
