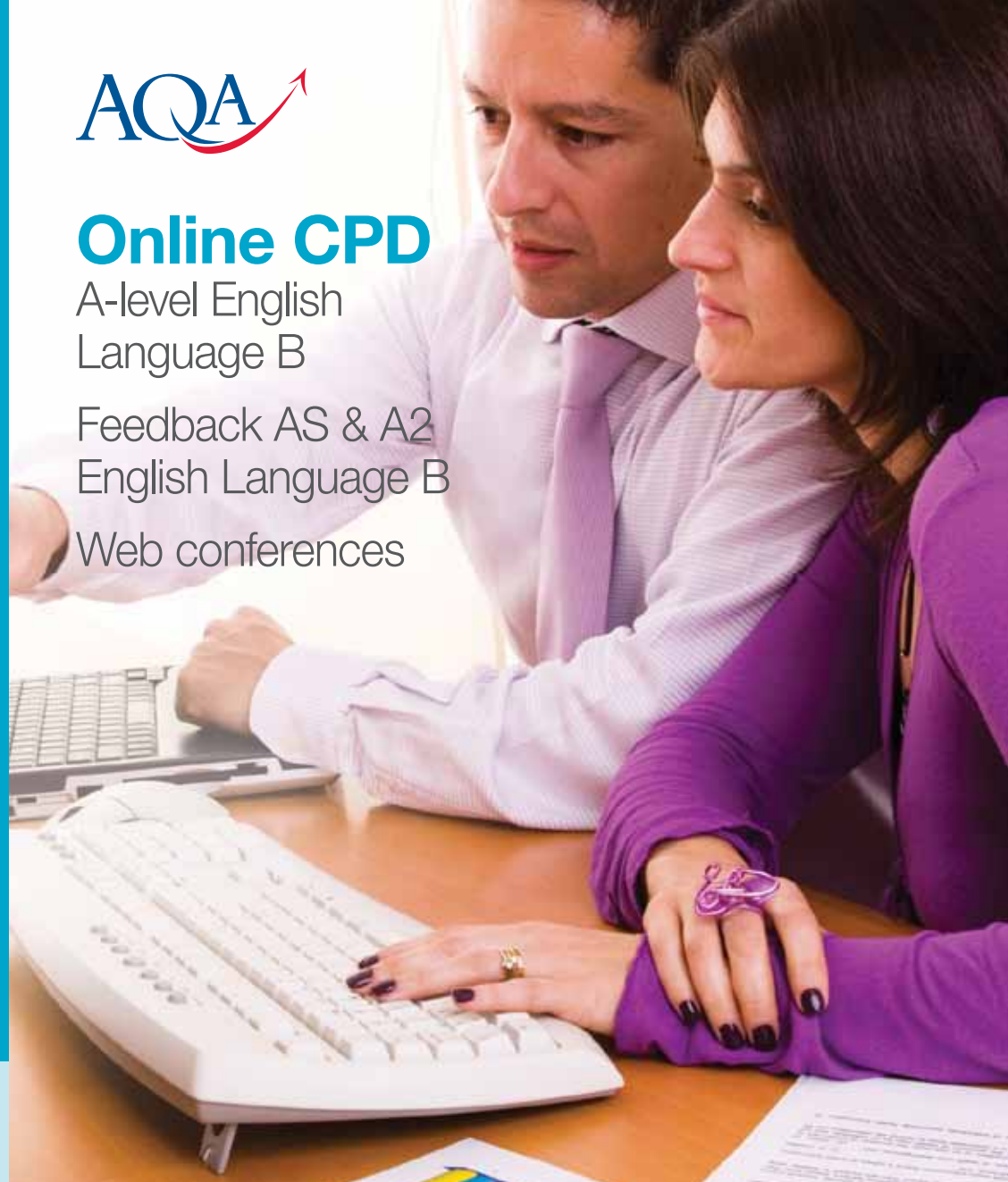

A-level English Language B: Feedback on AS & A2 Web conferences

We know that it is harder for you to be released from school/college for training, so we've developed our 'feedback' events for A-level subjects into web conferences. As a Head of Department or subject teacher, these events will help you to focus your teaching to help your students to achieve their full potential.

The events run between either 16:15–18:15 pm or 16:30–18:30 pm (depending on the date of the web conference), so you can join in from home or work, whichever suits you best. The events are interactive – you will be able to key in questions; join in typed 'chat' sessions; take part in polling activities and marking exercises.

- Appraisal of mid-range responses
- Bridging the gap: how to improve performance
- Implications for teaching and learning.
