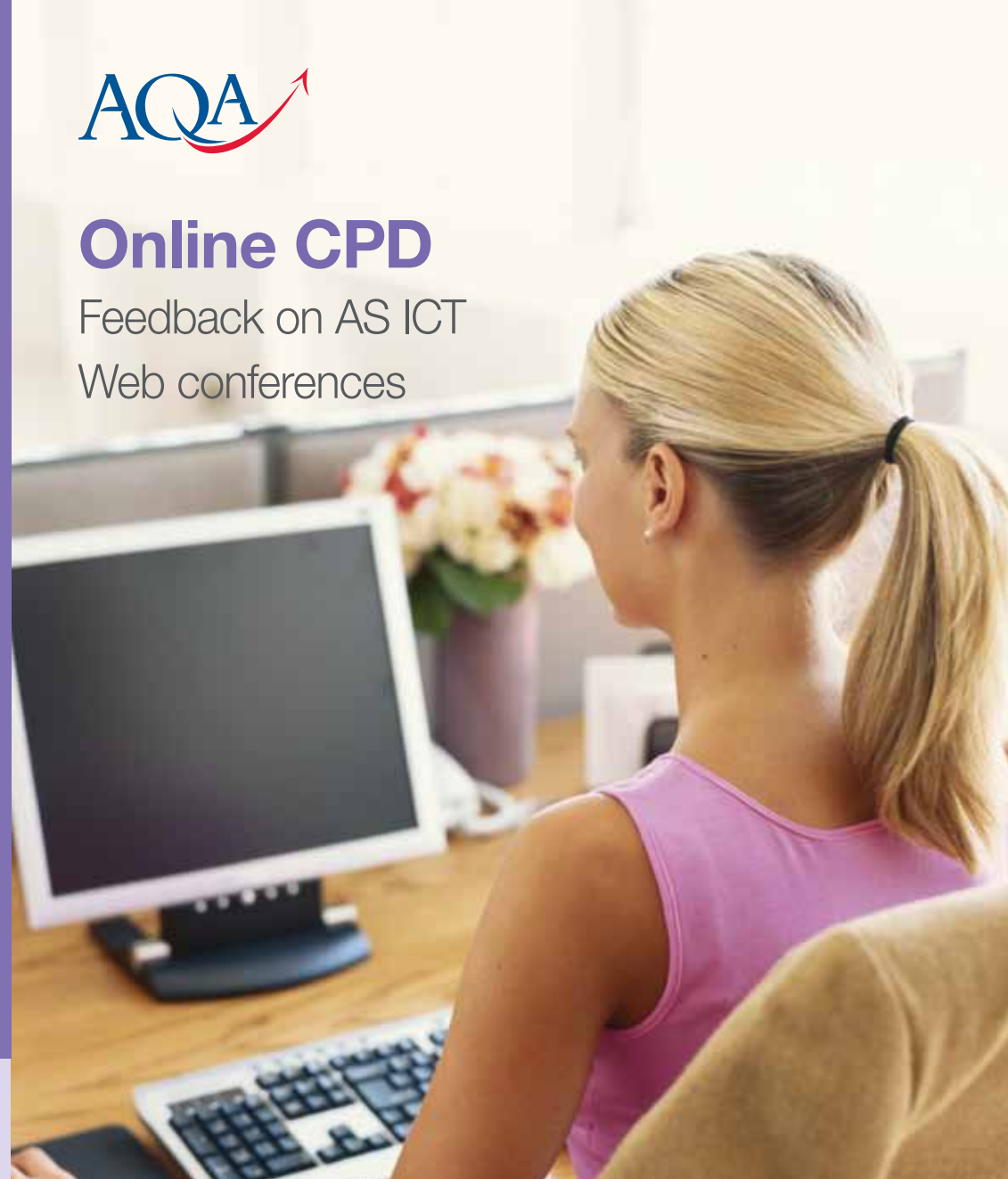
Please note that if you cancel a booking, you should do so online at least 7 days before the web conference to qualify for a refund.
